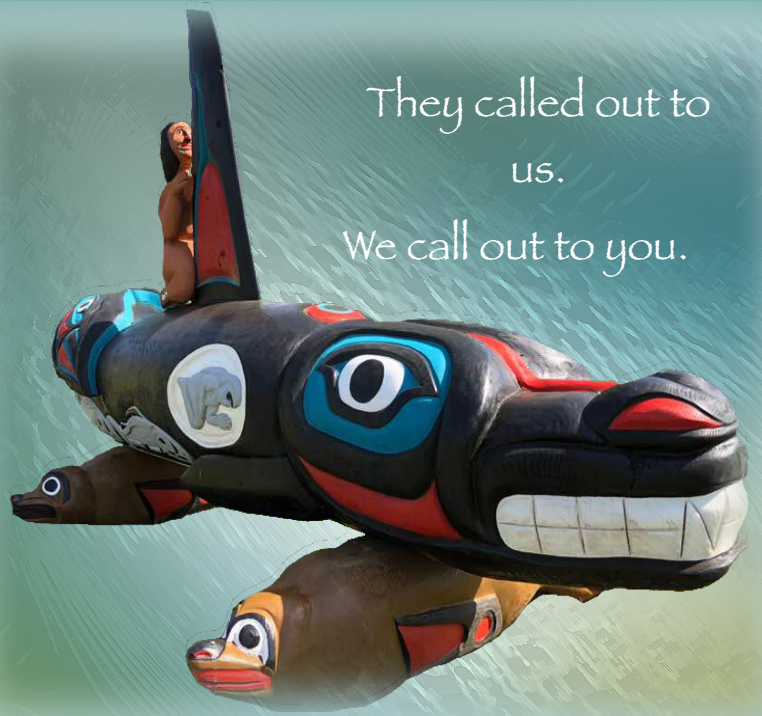

It is part of our Xa Xalh Xechnging (“sacred obligation”) to bring home from Miami Seaquarium the captive killer whale Tokitae and returning her to her family. The gathering is also dedicated to the survival and revival of her imperiled extended family—the Southern Resident Killer Whale population that live in our Salish Sea (Puget Sound) and rely on California coastal waters. It is ultimately a vision of resilience, truth, belonging, and healing for the qwe lhol mechen and for us all in a troubled time from which we shall rise again.
